Richard Allen Maury, age 70, passed away peacefully on August 23, 2015. He was born on April 25, 1945 to parents Oliver “Dick” David Maury and Vera Ione Maury. Rich grew up in East Lansing, Michigan where he attended East Lansing High School, class of 1963. After high school, Rich worked at, managed, and eventually became the sole proprietor of his parent’s successful bowling center, Holiday Lanes. Rich was instrumental in bringing the WIBC National Tournament to Lansing in 1992. In 1994 he was named “Proprietor of The Year” by the WIBC and in 1995 he was inducted into the Lansing Bowling Hall of Fame.

Rich sold Holiday Lanes in 2012 and enjoyed full time retirement on Drummond Island, Michigan and Titusville, Florida. Rich loved people, boats, traveling, and golf. He had a brilliant mind and was always thinking about his next invention. He will be greatly missed by many and fondly remembered for his incredible generosity, quick wit, and countless stories.
