- 1967-1969 Medical School – 2 years (MSU with 2nd class in new med school)

- I spent 6 months in the first WAMI Pediatric resident program to attract Physicians to Rural areas
 - Initiated a migrant clinic at the request of Dr. Green (protégé of Martin Luther King) Lansing Michigan presently active
- 1970 A Vietnam paramedic vet and 3 Doctors started Country Doctor clinic in an unserved clinic in Seattle (still active)
- 1971-1972 Internship at the Virginia Mason Hospital in Seattle
 - Made first preemie helicopter transfer to the University of Washington Preemie Center
- 1972-1974 University of Washington Seattle Children's Orthopedic Pediatric Residency
- 1975 worked in inner city Seattle Clinic

- 1976 started my Pediatric Practice in Puyallup, Washington in a small town (at the time)
- 1976-1978 worked at state incarcerated adolescent clinic once a week.
- 1978 four MD's and myself started the 3rd preemie center in the state
 - Worked for 2 ½ years
 - The usual articles in Tacoma papers and Hospital bulletins
- Also in 1978 Brought the first OB-GYN to the Puyallup community
 - Before this only General Practitioners made deliveries
- 1980 Built a medical building which brought the first Cardiologist, GI, Neurologist, Cardiovascular surgeon, ENT, Outpatient Surgery center, Oncology radiation and Oncology to the community
- 1990 developed the only private Pediatric Head Injury Rehab unit in the country (referral base was for 1 ½ million people)
- 1998 A team of myself and Nursing staff assisted planning a new OB-Delivery department with a level 2 intensive nursery
- 1986-2005 I was the Puyallup High School Physician for football and soccer, I attended all away and home games
- 1978-2009 I was a usual chairman all at the committees. Attended OG-GYN, Pediatrics and Emergency room monthly committees for 33 years.
- I was the Debate Judge for Puyallup High school
- Helped at the Puyallup Fair
 - 1,000,000 visitors for 2 weeks
 - Helped with Triage
 - On the committee for concussion control
